

**Devon County Council (Bullhorn Cross to Chapel Cross, Bigbury)
(Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order**

Devon County Council make this order in exercise of powers under sections 1 & 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 & of all other enabling powers

- 1 This order comes into force _____ and may be cited as “Devon County Council (Bullhorn Cross to Chapel Cross, Bigbury) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order _____”

- 2 Except as provided in article 3 it is a contravention for a person to cause or permit a motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road in the schedule

- 3 Nothing in article 2 applies if the vehicle is
 - a) an emergency service vehicle
 - b) being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
 - c) being used for a specified period in connection with any of the following operations in or adjacent to that length of road
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic
 - (iii) in connection with statutory undertakers plant or equipment
 - (iv) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road
